**A non-competition licence (also know as a leisure licence)** covers you while you are out training, on club spins, and while participating in leisure tours. The fee is €40 (€35 for your Cycling Ireland licence along with a €5 provincial levy) if you are based in Leinster, Munster or Connacht and is £26 / €35 (New Member) or £34 / €45 (returning member) if you are based in Ulster. Insurance cover and benefits for a non-competition licence are the same as any other licence but it does not cover you to race in competitive events.

**A limited competition licence** allows you to compete in all domestic competition except open road races. It replaces the Restricted licence choices and also covers Club Competition. In other words you may use a Limited Competition licence to compete in Track, BMX, Off-Road, Time-Trials, Hill-Climbs, Club Racing, Bicycle-polo and Artistic Cycling. This licence is not specific to one discipline, it covers them all. It does not include Open Road Racing. The licence types included in this category are Limited Competition (LC) for adults over 18 years of age. Under Eight (U8) & Under Ten (U10) Youth licences are also classed as Limited Competition. The LC licence is €60 if you are in a club and €90 if you are not in a club. There is a further €10 charge if you are from Ulster. The reason for the higher fees in Ulster is that the province has elected (at the provincial AGM) to levy a provincial fee upon each member rather than each club. Leinster, Munster and Connaught charge each club a provincial fee rather than each member.

**Full Competition Licences** :This licence costs €125 if you are in a club, and €155 if you are not in a club. There is a further €10 charge if you are from Ulster. This licence qualifies you for racing in any discipline (including offroad, bmx, TT etc) in Ireland. If you want to race overseas you can get overseas authorisation for an extra €20, and submit/upload a photo ID electronically. If you want to race on the road in open races, this is the type of licence you want. The categories you can select from are based on your ability, the highest being A+, which is reserved for those road riders who are on pro-teams (with the exception of female pro riders). A1 is the next highest category, then A2, the majority of the members are either A3 or A4 riders, with the A4 category being reserved for new members, and weaker/less experienced riders. The distances vary depending on the category. In general, all riders taking out their first senior/veterans full competition license must take out an A4 license. For information on upgrading/downgrading, see cycle ireland website.

Full competition licenses are also available to riders in the Under 12, Under 14 and Under 16 age categories. For riders in the U12 & U14 categories the cost is €5/£5. For riders in the U16 category the cost is €35/ £29 for riders who are club members and €65/£54 for un-attached members. Riders who do not wish to take part in races but still wish to cycle may take out a leisure membership instead of a full competition license.

I hereby apply to be admitted as a member of Cycling Ireland, and agree that, if accepted, I will be bound by the Rules of the Federation. I understand, and agree, that I participate in events, whether on the public highway or otherwise, at my own risk, and that no liability whatever will attach to the promoter, promoting club, or any officials of any cycling event nor to Cycling Ireland, Provincial Board affiliated thereto, for any injury, loss or damage suffered by me in or by reason of any event however such may be caused. I hereby declare that I am aware of no reason why I should not be issued with the licence requested. I undertake to spontaneously return my licence in the event of any substantial change to the circumstances existing at the time of the application for a licence. I declare that I have not applied for a licence for the same year to the UCI or to any other national federation. I assume exclusive liability for this application and for the use that I shall make of the licence. I hereby undertake to respect the constitution and regulations of the International Cycling Union, its continental confederations and its national federations. I declare that I have read or have had the opportunity to become acquainted with the aforesaid constitution and regulations. I shall participate in cycling competitions or events in a fair and sporting manner. I shall submit to disciplinary measures taken against me and shall take any appeals and litigation before the authorities provided for in the regulations. I accept the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) as the sole competent body for appeals in such cases and under the conditions set out in the regulations. I accept that the CAS shall be the court of last instance and that its decisions shall be definitive and without right of appeal. With those reservations, I shall submit any litigation with the UCI solely to the courts within whose jurisdiction the head offices of the UCI lie. I agree to submit to and be bound by the UCI Antidoping regulations, the clauses of the World Antidoping Code and its International Standards to which the UCI anti-doping regulations refer and to the anti-doping regulations of other competent bodies as per the regulations of the UCI and the World Antidoping Code provided that they comply with that Code. I agree that the results of the analysis may be made public and communicated in detail to my club or team or to my paramedical assistant or doctor. I agree that all urine samples taken shall become the property of the UCI, which may have them analysed, especially for purposes of health protection research and information. I agree that my doctor or the doctor of my club or team may, on a request from the UCI, communicate to it a list of any medicines I took and treatment I underwent before any given competition. I accept the conditions regarding blood testing and accept to undergo blood tests.
